

# QUESTION 6 - WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

Nevada's abortion law (NRS442.250) was voted on during the 1990 election. It can only be changed by a vote of the people. No elected official can change it, but Question 6 will. **QUESTION 6 WILL FACE FINAL APPROVAL ON THE NOVEMBER 2026 BALLOT.**

<b>A "NO" VOTE</b> <b>Current law remains</b>	<b>A "YES" VOTE</b> <b>Amends NV. Constitution</b>
Abortion up to six months	Abortion in 7 <sup>th</sup> , 8 <sup>th</sup> , and 9 <sup>th</sup> month up to birth
Parental notification <b>required</b> prior to a teen/preteen abortion	No Parental Involvement EVER
Only Licensed Physicians can perform abortion	Expanded to practitioner of healthcare (nurse, chiropractor, etc)
Health and safety regulations remain	State and local government can NOT regulate for health and safety
Miscarriage care and ectopic pregnancy treatment protected	Unchanged
No woman is punished for an abortion	Women punished by unqualified practitioners in unsanitary locations
