Complete Required Supreme Forms

Please verify that the following forms have been submitted to ensure council compliance and Star Council eligibility:

- Form 185: Report of Officers Chosen for the Term
- Form 365: Service Program Personnel Report
- Form SP-7: Columbian Award Application

Check Star Council Requirements

Please review your council's status via Officers Online to ensure all requirements have been met, including:

- Membership growth
- Fraternal Benefit Event requirements
- Program requirements
- Safe Environment compliance and reporting
- Submission of all required forms

Supreme Per Capita Billing

If your council has not yet paid its Supreme Per Capita bill, please do so immediately to remain in good standing and maintain Star Council qualification.

Review Officer Online Reports Often

Grand Knights and Financial Secretaries should log into KofC.org and review the Reports tab under Officers Online at least two times a week. This online section tracks outstanding forms, Safe Environment status, and membership goals that require attention before the year ends.

Together, let us finish this fraternal year strong and rally the 8,000+ Nevada Knights for the final push to defeat the Question 6 referendum and also redouble efforts for a successful year of growth and generous service to our neighbors.
